

Exhibit B: Barn Rules REVISED DECEMBER 2014

GERMANTOWN BARN SAFETY RULES

DO NOT ENTER any fenced pasture or the gated area West of our barn entrance. If a dog enters a pasture area with farm animals or is lost on or near the property, **NOTIFY THE HOME OWNER** right away. Do not approach livestock. Livestock guardians can be dangerous to anything they perceive as a threat. Livestock can be unpredictable and/or dangerous when frightened or chased.

STAY WELL CLEAR from any mechanized equipment, even if you think the operator sees you.

You can open the West sliding doors for ventilation if you understand their proper operation. Always latch and/or secure all doors, while open or closed. **Do not go out the East doors or allow dogs through the East doors.**

DO NOT THROW anything at or towards any livestock area or restricted area.

High wind area: SECURE ALL DOORS AT ALL TIMES (use latches to secure doors while opened OR closed, or block them with a very heavy object).

NO ONE is permitted to enter the building for any reason until the designated leader is present.

IT IS THE LEADER'S responsibility to open the barn, take care of the lights and stay until everyone has finished working. During evening hours the leader is also responsible for closing the entry gate when leaving the barn area.

ONLY Columbia Agility Club members are allowed to run dogs within the barn. The only exceptions are students participating in a CAT agility class. **UNLESS** your dog is on the course, it shall be confined to a crate or x-pen, or under physical control by a lead.

DO NOT LET YOUR DOG OFF LEAD OUTSIDE THE BARN.

ONLY ONE dog may be run on the course at a time. During warm-ups, more than one dog may be on the course providing all dogs are on lead.

THE COURSE DESIGN will be at the discretion of the leader. Anyone desiring to change the course or training activity should seek the leader's approval before moving obstacles.

DOG FECAL material must be picked up and bagged and left in the designated container at each facility. DO NOT place plastic bags in the Portable Toilet. Handlers must spray any soiled areas inside the barn with the disinfectant spray bottle provided. Please do not leave food treats and material in the arena grounds.

NO FEMALE DOGS IN HEAT are permitted within the barn area, or in the parking area at any time.

DESIGNATED LEADERS must promptly report ALL incidents involving any injury to persons or animals, or property damage, to the respective Barn Managers.
