The owners of the training barns deserve common courtesy and thoughtfulness from the CAT members and students using their facilities. Please check the specific rules for each site. These rules and guidelines are for the safety of both dogs and handlers. In general, the rules are:

1. No one is permitted to enter the building for any reason until the instructor is present.
2. It is the instructor's responsibility to open the barn, take care of lights and stay until everyone has finished working.
3. Only Columbia Agility Club members are allowed to run dogs in the barn. The only exceptions are students participating in a CAT agility class or seminar.
4. Unless your dog is on the course, it must be confined to a crate or x-pen or under physical control by a lead. **DO NOT LET YOUR DOG OFF LEAD OUTSIDE THE BARN.**
5. Only one dog may be run on the course at a time.
6. The course design will be at the discretion of the instructor. Please do not change the course or training activity without instructor approval.
7. Dog fecal material (yes, poop!) must be picked up and bagged and disposed of in the garbage can located outside the barn. Do not place plastic bags in the Portable Toilet. Handlers must spray any soiled areas inside the barn with the disinfectant spray bottle provided. Please do not leave food treats and material in the arena grounds.
8. **NO FEMALE DOGS IN HEAT** are permitted in the barn or in the parking area at any time.
9. Instructors must promptly report ALL incidents involving any aggression, injury to persons or animals, or property damage, to the Training Director.

I have read the attached guidelines for Columbia Agility Team classes/seminars and the Barn Rules and agree to abide by them and to follow the guidelines set for by the instructors for the class/workshop. I certify that the entered dog does not constitute a danger to persons, dogs or property and that its rabies vaccination is current as required by the laws of the state in which it lives. No aggressive displays (by dog or human) will be allowed, and will result in immediate dismissal from the seminar with no refund. Any dog that has bitten a person or dog in the past to the extent that medical attention was necessary may not participate or be present for this seminar. I acknowledge that there are risks involved with training in dog agility and I agree to assume responsibility for any harm arising from these. I agree to hold harmless Columbia Agility Team, its instructors and officers, and the owners of the training barns. I acknowledge that by entering this seminar, I am or will be, a Limited Member of the Columbia Agility Team.
