CAT Refund Policy

A 100% refund will be given for any request received prior to the initial closing date for trial entries. Refunds in the amount of the entry fees less any unavoidable expenses incurred by CAT will be made for requests received after the initial closing date and up to the day before the trial if the refund is requested for the following reasons: dog in heat, injured or ill dog with verification from vet upon request, injured or ill handler with verification upon request and family emergency.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- Read updated rules section and Covid-19 recommendations/waiver.
- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the show committee.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s) and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog(s) and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the show committee, be asked to leave the show site. In that case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on the entry forms. Illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered in the show.

CRATING INFO

Limited crating space is available inside on dirt near the ring. Please remember this is private property. Exercise your dog responsibly. Pick up after your dog at the show site and around the hotels. All dogs must be on leash except when in the ring or warm up area. Dogs left unattended must be secured in a crate or x-pen. No tethering of unattended dogs is allowed. ABSOLUTELY NO PROPANE HEATERS ARE ALLOWED ON THE FAIRGROUNDS PREMISES.

No Prong Collars Allowed.

PRIZES & AWARDS

Placement ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 4th place for Qualifying and non-qualifying scores for all classes. Dogs with an NT (no time) are not eligible for any ribbons. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score, and Jr. Handlers in Standard.

MEASURING

Measuring will be done on Saturday and Sunday from 7:15 am to 7:30 am. General briefing will be given following measuring each morning, prior to the first class briefing. Competitors not attending the general briefing will still be subject to the terms and conditions set forth in such a briefing. Neither the judge nor the host club is required to provide details of the general briefing once it has been given. **THERE WILL BE NO MEASURING** of dogs after judge's first briefing each day. All dogs without a permanent card must be measured before the judge's briefing to show that day. **THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS!!!**

General CPE rules for entries/show site:

- > Dogs must be at least 15 months or older the first day of the trial
- Blind (both eyes), lame, in season or aggressive dogs may not enter the show. The Club may choose to exclude any of the above from the site.
- Dogs must be registered with CPE prior to the closing date of the trial, or by the trial date for Day of Show entries. Registration forms are on the Forms page: <u>www.k9cpe.com</u>. Forms MUST be mailed to CPE and are processed 2-3 times per week. CPE ID numbers are emailed to legible email addresses. Registrations can only be processed from mailed forms.
- Dogs must be able to be measured at their first show. If a dog cannot be measured, the dog cannot run and no refund will be issued. Dogs within ½" of a jump height require at least one more measurement. When dogs reach their second birthday, a measurement is required. All dogs must be measured at their first trial regardless of jump height.
- > Only CPE Judges can measure dogs.
- > Electronic shock collars are not allowed at ANY CPE trial training or bark.
- Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. A warm-up jump shall be provided for all entered dogs. No relieving of dogs in the warm-up area.

Dogs in the ring, leashes, exiting the ring

- Dogs shall run without anything attached to its body. This is for the safety of the dog. This includes no: collars, stitches, wraps or any other item. The only exception is a small barrette or rubber band to keep hair out of a dog's eyes.
- Leashes may not have anything (other than name/license tags) attached to them when used in the ring.
- Dogs may enter the ring on a collar, quick release harness or head halti/leader. If prong collars are allowed per the show site, they may *not* be used to take a dog into the ring.
- Handlers may not carry their leash with them on the course if done so, an NT will result. Exception: Handicapped handlers that have a mobility

problem in picking up the leash at the finish may put their leash in their pocket – the leash must be out of sight.

Dogs must be under the handler's control when leaving the ring or the judge may enter the run as No Time - NT.

Declared Training in the Ring

We (CAT) will offer Declared Training in the Ring. The handler has the option if they want to use a toy or training aid at any time during their run, the handler must approach the Judge during Walkthrough or previously in that trial day for the Judge to approve the toy or training aid for use on the course.

Handler must alert the Judge upon entry to the ring that the dog will be TIR. Handler is then allowed to have a reasonably sized silent toy/aid with them for use once their run has started (this toy must be approved by the Judge of record PRIOR to the start of the class to determine its eligibility, absolutely no food/scents/audible devices). The toy is NOT allowed to be used in either gate chute or prior to the previous dog leaving the ring.

See the online rulebook or current member letter for additional rules.

- The following items *are* considered training in the ring (see Fix and Go):
- Violating the 4-paw safety rule (directing the dog back onto the contact)
- Start line stay leaving the dog and going back again to reposition the dog after the handler passes the plane of the first obstacle (before the handler leaves the dog, repositioning or repeated commands can be a delay of start)
- > Putting the dog back on the table in the point games

While running on course

- > The handler will direct the dog through the course without a collar or lead.
- Food, toys, training devices (includes fanny packs and leash attachments) are not allowed within 10' feet of the ring. Clickers, training whistles and squeaky toys are not to be used within distraction distance of the ring.
- The handler may not carry anything that could aid the dog in its performance. Exclusion: Handicapped/Differently Abled Handlers using a cane, scooter, wheelchair, etc., to enable their progression around the course.

The handler may use any verbal or visual commands to direct the dog through the course. The Judge may assess a 5-fault penalty to elimination for any command that is not given in a sportsmanlike manner. Faults can be, but are not limited to: foul or abusive language, display of anger, extreme frustration or excessive harshness. If the fault is severe enough, the Judge has the right to excuse the exhibitor from the ring and / or the remainder of the trial. If excused from the trial, a report would be filed with CPE. See Faults, Eliminations and Excusals in the rulebook.

This also includes if there was a correction to a scribe sheet – the handler must verify that the results were corrected as well.

An ID Number is required to enter a CPE trial. Pending ID numbers cannot be accepted.

Waiver of Liability and Informed Consent COVID-19 Waiver

Hereafter, Canine Performance Events, Inc. will be referred to as CPE. Hereafter, Cowlitz County Event Center will be referred to as Site. Hereafter, Columbia Agility Team will be referred to as Club.

- I attest that to the best of my knowledge, I do not have COVID-19 at the time of attending this event, and understand the risks of unknowing exposure to this and other illnesses by or to myself, my family, other participants, and third parties. CPE TRIAL GUIDELINES EFFECTIVE MAY 11, 2020

This information is in effect until Dec. 31, 2020. Premium was required to be submitted before this date, so there may be updates to this information.

GLOVES: Gloves are an individual choice unless the club requires them for something or as suggested below. Studies show frequent hand washing is better than gloves in many cases. Gloves may need to be used for handing out ribbons, bottles of water, etc. In that case, the wearer must be VERY aware of not touching anything else during that time. If as an exhibitor, you prefer to wear gloves, you will need to bring enough for the times you will need to wear them. Please dispose of gloves properly.

MASKS: Masks are to be worn by anyone within the ring (building, walking, running, judging). Masks are up to the individual, club, local, state and government guidelines when not within the ring. Exhibitors who will be wearing masks will need to bring enough masks for the duration of the trial and dispose of single use masks properly.

LEASHES: Dogs must still run naked. All handlers have the choice to put their leash in their pocket or safely loop it around their waist or neck, it does not have to be out of the dog's sight, however, if the dog plays with it during the run, it would be considered a toy. If the handler cannot carry their leash, leashes will be dropped on the ground/floor at the start line and the leash runner will pick it up with a gripper device and place it at the exit gate on a chair or the ground/floor. Do not loop leashes on the ring barrier.

LIMITS: The Club will follow all Washington State, CPE & Cowlitz County Event Center requirements regarding COVID-19. Crating, Measuring and Vendor information may have to be changed. There may **not** be any inside crating, vendors or measuring depending on the requirements. Please plan accordingly.
